

Oakwood's NSCAA All-Americans

The Oakwood Soccer Club is pleased to announce that Adam LaPlaca, Leon Carby, AJ Stueck, and Phil Ziegler have all been named 2009 NSCAA High School All-Americans. These 4 players have over 25 combined years playing for Oakwood and they make up 80% of the boys All-Americans selected from the state of CT (total of 5 boys chosen).

LaPlaca (Glastonbury) was selected as one of only 4 goalkeepers from across the United States. Adam will be attending the University of Notre Dame starting in the fall, and will play on the men's soccer team under coach Bobby Clark.

Carby (West Hartford) was selected after leading his team to a second consecutive New England Prep School Championship. In his high school career, Leon scored 137 goals and assisted on 75. Leon has not yet decided which college he will attend come fall.

Stueck (Brookfield) lead his high school team to this year's state championship. A central midfielder, AJ possesses the attacking tools to change games. He has been a member of Oakwood's US Soccer Development Academy teams for the past 3 years. AJ will continue his studies and soccer career at Northeastern University.

Ziegler (East Lyme) has been a member of Oakwood's US Soccer Development Academy teams for the past 3 years. Used primarily as a forward, Phil has a high fitness level and strong understanding of the game that make him a very effective wide player as well. He is a tireless worker that will continue his education and soccer career at Providence College.
