U-15/16 Style of Play Comments:

The Oakwood U-15/16 team emphasizes the development of an attacking style of play with building out of the back and through midfield, moving the ball simply on the ground, and transferring the ball from one side to the other. However, they lack the comfort and experience to sustain technical quality, consistent quick support to open spaces, and concentration which often leads to reverting back to forcing too many direct balls up the field in the air. They display improving awareness, ability, and belief to adapt to this style of play along with commitment in training from the coach but it is a work in progress. The academy experience is new to the entire roster due to an imbalance in age groups last season (used only 93 age players). This problem in style of play and lack of a streamlined approach between age groups within the club that is necessary for player development is likely to continue next season with poor roster formulation again this season-using all 94's with only 1 '95 birth year. It is positive to see 2 94's benefitting from frequent move-up to the U-17/18 team.

U-17/18 Style of Play Comments:

The Oakwood SC U-17/18 team display similar style and qualities as their younger team. Although they have similar issues with experience and consistency, they have been even more challenged to impose their style and develop a personality due to injuries to key attacking players, lack of initiative and leadership on the field, and poor focus. On the other hand their attacking play benefits from the move-up of a 94 forward with strong work ethic and motivation and they display an added strength in attack with forward Matheson (new player to club this season). He has some dynamic qualities and when combined with awareness in midfield it allows them to develop a style of creating chances from quick attacks in transition although they have struggled to finish.
