Senior Program (Session I) Ages 13–18

The Senior Program is designed for players age 13 and up. Modern coaching methods will be emphasized. Functional training for specific positions and roles within a team framework will be introduced. All technical instruction will be match-related. The training exercises will be physical as well as mental. The mental development of the campers is a key objective of the Program. Each day senior campers will have full-sided and small-sided matches under the supervision of USSF "A" licensed coaches. Curriculum includes: technical refinement, combination play, principles of attack and defense, individual, group and team tactics. 11 vs 11 and 8 vs 8 matches will be held Sunday–Wednesday at 6:30pm. Final matches will be held Thursday afternoon at 1:30 pm.

Junior Program (Sessions I & II) ages 10–12

The Select coaching philosophy is to have fun while learning. The dynamic coaching personalities of our staff will motivate the junior and youth campers. This is a key objective of this program. Curriculum includes: passing, shooting, receiving, heading, tackling, dribbling, movement with and without the ball and positional play and responsibilities. Matches will be held each evening Monday–Wednesday and Thursday afternoon.

Select Goalkeeper Academy (Sessions I & II)

The program provides individualized instruction with the most advanced training concepts. The Academy teaches goalkeepers in four areas: physical fitness, technique, tactical and psychological. Goalkeepers will gain added experience each day in full-match situations.

Premier Academy (Session II) ages 12–18

This Academy is for premier field players and goalkeepers who aspire to play in college. Enrollment is limited. After receiving your initial application you may be required to forward a soccer resume and the recommendation of your coach. The purpose of the session is to pool premier high school players together under the supervision of nationally "A" licensed coaches who will challenge and help elevate these players to the next level. The staff is select, the curriculum extremely challenging and the rewards great. Since 1987 campers have participated from 14 different State Olympic Development Programs as well as international teams from Germany, Argentina and England. Competitive matches each evening will make for a great week. Physical testing scores will be included with each players evaluation. After an exhausting 5 days of soccer this camp will end on Thursday afternoon at 3 pm.
